Theme:

Instructions:

Each of us has our own dreams that we want to pursue, and it is only within ourselves that we know how passionate we are in making this dreams come alive. This illustration competition is an opportunity to show how true you are in showing yourself reaching for that ultimate dream of yours.

Pick one of these quotes and interpret them in an illustration using your media of choice (traditional art media on paper):

- “All our dreams can come true if we have the courage to pursue them.” - Walt Disney
- “What seems to us as bitter trials are often blessings in disguise.” - Oscar Wilde
- “Remember your dreams and fight for them. You must know what you want from life. There is just one thing that makes your dream become impossible: the fear of failure.” - Paulo Coelho
- “The biggest adventure you can take is to live the life of your dreams.” - Oprah Winfrey

Rules and Regulations

- The time to create the artwork is 2 hours.
- After the 2 hours is done, participants are given additional time only to write the concept of their artwork on a separate paper.
- Participants are to create an illustration using traditional art media (watercolor, poster color, drawing markers, ink, etc.) on paper.
- You may use one medium or a combination of the media allowed.
- The drawing paper will be provided by the event committee.
- Drawing tools are not provided, as the participants will have to provide the needed tools themselves.
- During the competition, participants are not allowed to write their names, or leave a signature on the artwork, which would reveal their identity. This is for the purpose of judging process. Participants are only allowed to include their registration number as instructed by the committee.
- During the competition, participants are not allowed to bring inside the competition room, drawings or sketch(es) prepared beforehand. All drawings are made from the beginning during the competition within the time-limit.
- Participants have to abide by all the rules and regulations set by the event committee and to follow instructions from the committee during the competition running.

Restrictions

- Participants are not allowed to include elements that offend particular ethnic group, tradition, race, and religion (SARA).

Ownership

- The artwork will be returned to participants during the announcement of the winner or at the closing of the event.
- Binus Northumbria School of Design; Graphic Design and New Media Program, as well as Binus Artvolution committee will retain the rights to publish the artwork solely for the purpose of promoting the current or next events related. Any use outside promoting Binus Artvolution events, is subject to prior discussion and agreement with the participants.
- If participants fail to attend the announcement of the winner or at the closing of the event, please contact the committee within 1 week after the event. Binus Artvolution committee will not hold responsibility for any loss of artworks that are not retrieved during the timeframe mentioned.
